



SENIORS SUPPORTS AND RESOURCES

The City of Brampton offers many resources and supports for adults ages 55 years and older.

SNOW REMOVAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

A financial assistance program to help seniors and people with disabilities with costs incurred from hiring a service provider to remove snow from their sidewalks and driveways.

FREE ANNUAL TRANSIT PASS

Brampton Transit offers a free annual transit pass for seniors. Eligible residents require a Brampton Transit Senior Identification Card and PRESTO Card loaded with the free annual pass.

RECREATION DISCOUNTS

Adults ages 55+ get discounts on registered programs and memberships (select exclusions apply). Beginning June 2024, residents ages 70+ are eligible for a free annual recreation membership.

SENIOR AFFILIATED GROUPS

Join not-for-profit community volunteer groups that provide leisure, social and other special interest opportunities.

PROPERTY TAX ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

A tax rebate on annual property taxes for low-income seniors and low-income persons with disabilities who own and occupy their own home.

ANIMAL SERVICES LICENSING DISCOUNT

Pet owners ages 55+ receive discounted pet licensing fees.
