- 2. A complete application includes ensuring that all required information is provided; all taxes due as of the date of the desired City Council meeting have been paid and the appropriate required insurance is in currently force.
- 3. The selection of a City Council meeting date in Section 4 of this Form is done solely for the identification of requested timing requirements and in no way should be construed as a commitment by City staff to forward a by-law to a particular meeting of City Council. In the event that application deficiencies are identified subsequent to the City's receipt of a complete application, approval of the application and finalization of the by-law will be delayed pending rectification of those deficiencies.
- 4. City Council meeting dates can be confirmed by contacting the City Clerk's Office. Typically, meeting dates of City Council for a new calendar year are approved at the last meeting of City Council in December. Council meeting dates are subject to change or cancellation.
