The City of Brampton, in collaboration with the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority, is improving wetland habitat and connectivity along Etobicoke Creek from Conservation Drive Park to Loafers Lake Park. Funded in part by the Government of Ontario, the Etobicoke Creek Wetlands Enhancement Project will improve many features at Loafers Lake including a new shoreline, viewing platforms and trail realignment. Planting of native trees, shrubs and aquatic plants

will also be undertaken throughout the project area.

Project Timeline: March 2024 - December 2024

Loafers Lake Closure: April 2024 - December 2024

Loafers Lake and the portion of the Etobicoke Creek Trail around the lake will be closed during the project. Detour routes and signage will be available.
