To obtain a Special Effects Pyrotechnic Permit, the Pyrotechnician Supervisor will need to provide the following:

1.	Complete a Special Effects	Attached
	Pyrotechnic Application and Event	
	Plan including fire safety measures	
2.	Provide proof of level of certification	Attached
	by providing photocopies of NRD	
	Special Effects Certification Card	
3.	Provide verification that the property	Attached
	owner has given permission to set off	
	pyrotechnics on his or her property.	
4.	Provide proof of \$5,000,000 liability	Attached
	insurance with the City of Brampton	
	listed as co-insured.	
5.	Provide a list of all products being	Attached
	used, including the manufacturer for	
	the purpose of cross referencing with	
	ERD's List of Authorized Products.	
6.	Provide a floor plan showing the	Attached
	location and the firing site.	
7.	Arrange to conduct a site	Completed
	demonstration of the most volatile
