Achieving Innovation and Manufacturing Excellence – AIME

AIME offers manufacturers in south, central and eastern Ontario up to \$50,000 to offset the costs of training or skills development to support innovation.

Canada-Ontario Job Grant

Provides funding to individuals identified by employers in need of skills improvement. The grant covers up to two-thirds of eligible training costs, up to a maximum of \$10,000 per individual.
