BASIC SAFETY RULES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS PYROTECHNIC PERMIT

All Special Effects Pyrotechnics must follow the requirements of the Explosive Regulations 2013 and the Special Effects Pyrotechnics Manual from Natural Resources Canada.

Special Effects Pyrotechnic Permit Requirements

To obtain a Special Effects Pyrotechnic Permit, the Pyrotechnician Supervisor will need to provide the following:

1. Complete a Special Effects Pyrotechnic Application and Event Plan.
2. Provide proof of level of certification from Natural Resources Canada (NRCan).
3. Provide verification that the property owner has given permission to set off pyrotechnics on his or her property.
4. Provide proof of \$5,000,000 liability insurance with the City of Brampton listed as co-insured.
5. Provide a list of all products being used, including the manufacturer for the purpose of cross referencing with ERD's List of Authorized Products.
6. Provide a floor plan showing the location and the firing site.
7. Arrange to conduct a site demonstration of the most volatile product they intend to use, prior to the event.
