Emerging Health and Life Sciences Cluster

- New **\$500 million** world-class Peel Memorial Centre for Integrated Health and Wellness (PMC) has spurred the development of a new Health and Life Sciences cluster in the downtown centre
- Unique health cluster centralized around preventive care
- Targeting businesses involved with big data, health applications, population-based research and personalized medicine

Economic Impact

- \$35 trillion in GDP
- Generating **5,000 to 6,000** high-paying jobs and additional 13,000 jobs indirectly
- **1.5 million** square feet of additional office space

Health Cluster Advantages

- Home to three leading health care facilities: William Osler Health System (Peel Memorial, Brampton Civic) and ErinoakKids. **\$1 billion investment** by Province of Ontario
