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To change the name of Cabado Court to Alfred Kuehne Boulevard.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of Cabado Court to Alfred Kuehne Boulevard;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times and in the Brampton Guardian, both newspapers having general circulation within the City of Brampton, on the following dates; December 10th, December 17th, December 24th and December 31st, 1980;

AND WHEREAS the Council has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

The name of Cabado Court, the legal description of which is set out in Schedule A to this by-law, is hereby changed to Alfred Kuehne Boulevard. READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME AND PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of January, 1981.
