

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number <u>1-85</u>

To further amend By-law 63-82, providing for the licensing of adult entertainment parlours

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 63-82, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding subsection (la) after subsection l of section 6 as follows:

(1a) No licence will be issued under this by-law unless the adult entertainment parlour is located in a permitted area and is located not closer than 2,000 metres measured on a continuous path over the shortest distance from another adult entertainment parlour.

2. Section 13 of By-law 63-82 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

- (1) Before Council refuses to issue or to renew a licence, or before Council revokes a licence, a written notice shall be given to the applicant or licensee advising him that a recommendation is to be made to Council with respect to his licence application.
- (2) The notice under subsection (1) shall state that the applicant or licensee is entitled to be heard by Council, and that he may request a hearing by notice in writing to be delivered to the City Clerk within 7 days after the notice referred to in subsection (1) has been served on the applicant or licensee.
- (3) Where a request for a hearing has been received, the City Clerk shall appoint a time and place for the hearing and shall so advise the applicant or licensee in writing.
- (4) Where a hearing date before Council has been fixed and the applicant or licensee has been so advised in writing, in the event that the applicant or licensee does not attend at the place and on the time appointed for the hearing, Council may proceed to deal with the matter without further notice to the applicant or licensee.

(5) Upon the conclusion of a hearing, Council shall as soon as practicable, dispose of the matter which was the subject of the hearing, by doing any act or making any decision, and such decision shall be final.
