Number ___ 1 - 91

To accept and assume and to establish as public highways certain lands on Registered Plan M-269

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume certain streets and lands, and to establish other lands, shown on Registered Plan M-269 as public highways;

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands acquired by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby established as part of the public highway system.

2. The lands dedicated as public highways and described in Schedule B to this bylaw are hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system.
