



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 1-93

To authorize the transfer of
part of Block D, Plan M-75 and
part of Blocks C and G, Plan M-73
to The Regional Municipality of Peel

The Regional Municipality of Peel has made the portion of Bovaird Drive between Bramalea Road and Dixie Road part of the regional road network and has requested The Corporation of the City of Brampton to transfer certain buffer blocks abutting the southerly limit of the said Bovaird Drive to The Regional Municipality of Peel to permit the construction of noise walls.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between The Corporation of the City of Brampton and The Regional Municipality of Peel, together with all other documents that in the City Solicitor's opinion are necessary to effect the conveyance to The Regional Municipality of Peel for a purchase price of Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the following lands:

The lands situated in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel being the part of Block D, Registered Plan M-75 designated as Parts 5 and 7 on Reference Plan 43R-19449 and the part of Blocks C and G, Registered Plan M-73, designated as Parts 1, 3 and 4 on Reference Plan 43R-19449.


READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of January, 1993.
