
Being a By-law to assume and
dedicate land as road allowance.


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton

All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly Township of Chinguacousy in the County of Peel, and being composed of part of the East half of Lot 5, Concession 5, West of Hurontario Street and more particularly described as Part 1 of Reference Plan 43R-2595 lodged with the Land Registrar for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43).
