

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number _____2-2002

To authorize the expropriation of certain lands for the purpose of extending Sandalwood Parkway East and widening Bramalea Road

Section 191 of the Municipal Act authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands and interests in land herein described for the purpose of extending Sandalwood Parkway east of Bramalea Road and for widening Bramalea Road.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The expropriation of the part of Lot 13, Concession 5 1. East of Hurontario Street designated as Parts 1 to 5, both inclusive and Part 7 on Plan 43R-25561 for the purposes of extending Sandalwood Parkway East and widening Bramalea Road is hereby authorized. The expropriation of a three (3) metre permanent working and maintenance easement along the northerly limit of Part 6 on Plan 43R-25561 to facilitate the construction of Sandalwood Parkway East is also hereby authorized.
- 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as expropriating authority, all notices, applications, advertisements and other documents required by Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.26 as amended, by in order to effect the expropriation of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of January, 2002.


