## **BY-LAW**

Number <u>2 - 2009</u>

To enact a By-law to deem Lots 10, 11, 12, 17, 18, 19 and 20 ON Plan TOR-6 not to be Part of a Registered Plan of Subdivision for the purposes of subsection 50(3) of the Planning Act

**WHEREAS** City Council has passed By-law No. 288-2008 authorizing that Albert Street be stopped up, closed and declared surplus.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Albert Street merge with the adjacent landowner's lands upon closing of the sale transaction.

AND WHEREAS section 50(4) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, permits Council by By-law to designate any plan of subdivision or part thereof, that has been registered for eight years or more, to be deemed not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purpose of section 50(3) of the Planning Act.

**AND WHEREAS** Registered Plan TOR-6 was registered on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June, 1855.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. That Lots 10, 11, 12, 17, 18, 19 and 20 on Plan TOR-6 are hereby deemed not to be part of a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of subsection 50(3) of the Planning Act.
- 2. That the City Clerk be directed to send the notice of passage of the by-law as required by the Planning Act.

**READ** a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 28 day of January, 2009
