To declare as surplus and authorize the execution of
a release and abandonment of a hydro easement
(Part of Block 190, Plan 43M-1232 and part of
Golden Eagle Road)

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and the Brampton Hydro-Electric Commission have determined that the easement transferred to The Corporation of the City of Brampton and Brampton Hydro-Electric Commission by Instrument No. LT1715331 is no longer required for the purposes of the municipality or the commission;

AND WHEREAS the lands affected by the easement transferred in Instrument No. LT1715331 are more particularly described as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-21902;

AND WHEREAS Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 43R-21902 are owned by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and Part 3 on Plan 43R-21902 is owned by Wellingdale Financial Inc.;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The easement transferred by Instrument No. LT1715331 over the Part of Block 190, Plan 43M-1232 and part of Golden Eagle Road designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-21902 is hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a partial release and abandonment of the said easement affecting Part 3 on Plan 43R-21902 in favour of Wellingdale Financial Inc. The consideration for the release and abandonment of easement shall be Two Dollars (\$2.00).
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a partial release and abanadonment of the said easement affecting Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 43R-21902 in favour of The Corporation of the City of Brampton. The consideration for the release and abandonment of easement shall be Two Dollars (\$2.00).

READ a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD** TIME and **PASSED** in Open Council this 17th day of January, 2000.
