BY-LAW

Number 5-83

To amend By-law 200-82, as amended. (part of Lot 5, Concession 2, East of Hurontario Street).

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by changing the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from SERVICE COMMERCIAL (SC) to SERVICE COMMERCIAL - SECTION 214 (SC - SECTION 214),
- (2) by deleting Sheet 32 of Schedule A thereto, and substituting therefor Schedule B to this by-law, and
- (3) by adding thereto the following section:

214. The lands designated SC - Section 214 on Schedule A to this by-law:

214.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:

- (1) the purposes permitted in the SC zone by section 23.1.1, and
- (2) one billiard hall.

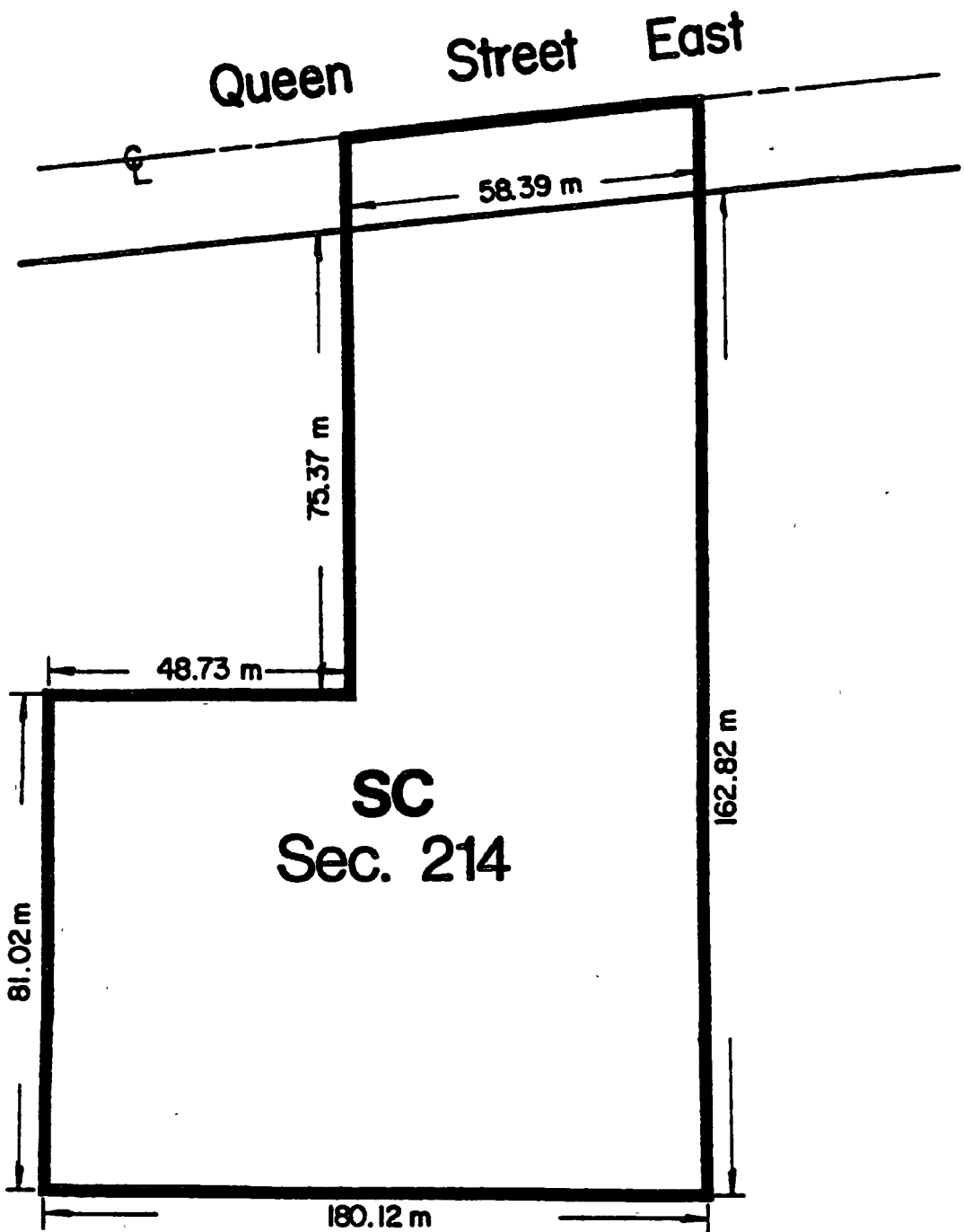
214.2 shall be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the SC zone.

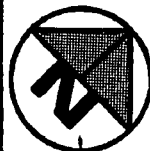

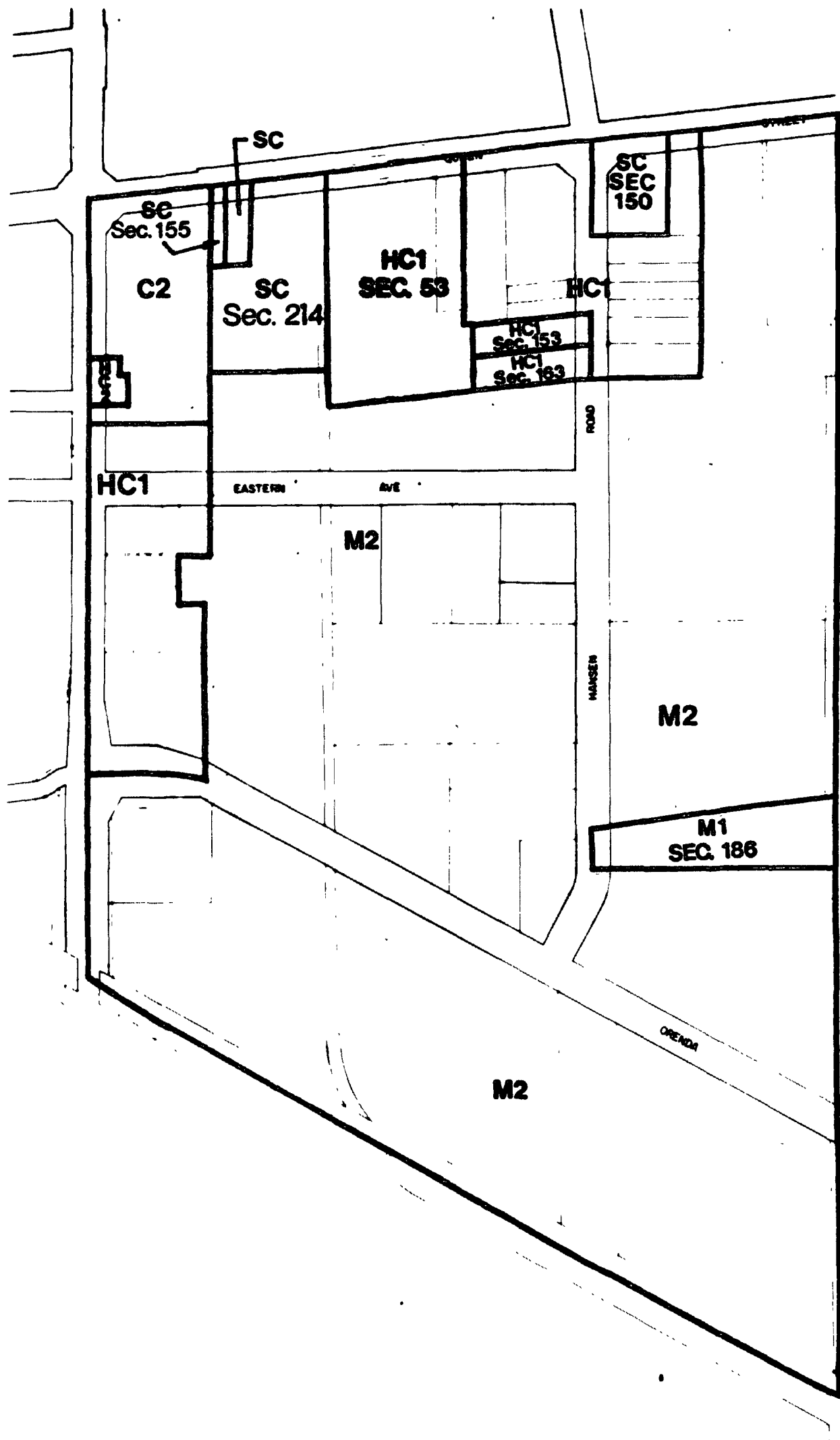


