
Schedule A to By-law Number 5-85

- (2) the whole of Crenshaw Court, as shown on the said Registered Plan M-106,
- (3) the whole of Tanager Square, as shown on the said Registered Plan M-106,
- (4) the whole of Huntley Court, as shown on the said Registered Plan M-106,
- (5) the part of Sandalwood Parkway shown on the said Registered Plan M-106, and
- (6) the whole of Block C, as shown on the said Registered Plan
