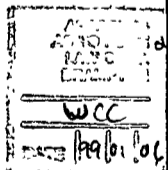
To declare as surplus and authorize

circle easements on Plan M-350


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that the easement described in Instrument No. 286003 is no longer required for the purposes of the municipality.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The easements described in Instrument No. 286003 over the lands described in Schedule A are hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a release and abandonment of the easements described in Instrument No. 289003. The consideration for the release and abandonment of easements shall be \$2.00.

SCHEDULE A to By-law 5-99

The City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel,

FIRSTLY: The part of Lots 14 and 15, Plan M-350, designated as parts 1 and 2 on plan 43R-8273.

SECONDLY: The part of Lots 21 and 22, Plan M-350, designated as parts 1 and 2 on plan 43R-8272.

THIRDLY: The part of Lot 40 and the part of Block G, Plan M-350, designated as parts 1 and 2 on plan 43R-8274.
