To authorize surplus lands and
transfer of an easement to The
Regional Municipality of Peel

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City transfer an easement over Part of Block 68, Plan 43M-1467 designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-28353 (the "Lands") to The Regional Municipality of Peel;

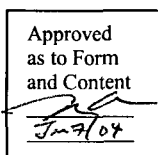
AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The transfer of easement for nominal consideration over the Lands to The Regional Municipality of Peel is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of easement of the said lands.
