

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 8-2006

To amend By-law 4-83, as amended, respecting the City of Brampton Safety Council

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 4-83, which established and created terms of reference and the composition of the City of Brampton Safety Council;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Recommendation SC124-2005, approved by Council on January 16, 2006, it is deemed expedient to increase the membership of the Brampton Safety Council to include representation from Parking Enforcement, Enforcement and By-law Services Division, Legal Services and to amend the representation from the Brampton Safe City Association;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 4-83, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - (1) By deleting Section 1. d) and substituting therefor the following:
 - "d) One representative from each of the following:
 - staff representative from Peel Regional Police Regional Traffic Unit
 - staff representative from City of Brampton Works and Transportation Department
 - staff representative from Student Transportation Office, Peel District School Board/Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board
 - staff representative from Brampton Fire and Emergency Services
 - representative from Brampton Safe City Association
 - representative from Parking Enforcement, Enforcement and By-law Services Division, Legal Services Department."
