**AND WHEREAS,** pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below for the purpose of creating maintenance easements is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

**NOW THEREFORE,** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 83, 87, and 121 on Registered Plan 43M-1881

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on January 30, 2016
