

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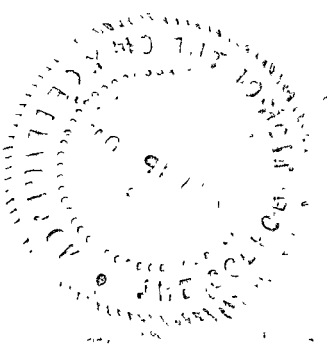

SCHEDULE 'A' TO

BY-LAW NUMBER 10-76

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, formerly the Town of Brampton, in the Township of Chinguacousy, in the County of Peel, and being composed of part of the West Half of Lot 2, Concession 2, East of Hurontario Street, more particularly described as being Part 10 as shown on a plan received and deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) on the first day of September, 1971 as Number 43R-407; (Part of Rutherford Road)

SUBJECT to an easement in favour of Ontario Water Resources Commission, as more particularly described in a Grant of Easement registered in the said Registry Office as Instrument Number 43420 for Brampton;

AND SUBJECT to an easement in favour of Canadian National Railway Company, as more particularly described in a Grant of Easement registered in the said Registry Office as Instrument Number 13153OVS for Brampton.
