To amend By-law 193-83 being a by-law for the regulation of traffic

3. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Schedule VIII thereof the following items under the appropriate columns thereof:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY COLUMN 2 BETWEEN

Haggert Avenue

The south limits of Railroad Street and the north limit of Queen Street.
