Section 6 of the <u>Municipal Act 2001</u> authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for the Shoppers World Transit Terminal.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. The expropriation of lands described as Part of Lot 1, Concession 1 WHS (Ching), designated as Part 5 on Reference Plan 43R-33012, in the City of Brampton, for the purposes upgrading the Shoppers World Terminal, is hereby authorized.
- 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as expropriating authority, all notices, applications, advertisements and other documents required by the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O 1990, c.E.26, as amended, in order to effect the expropriation of the said lands.
