Being a by-law to amend By-laws 808, 818, 825, 826 and 853 of the former Township of Toronto Gore.


The Council of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- That By-laws 808, 818, 825, 826 and 853 of the former Township of Toronto Gore be, and the same are, hereby amended to permit the lands described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto to be used only for the following purposes:
 - (a) That part of the lands shown on Schedule "A" which is designated as (ER) Estate Residential may be used for estate residential purposes as defined in By-law Number 1067.
 - (b) And that part of the lands shown on Schedule "A" designated as (RC) Recreational Commercial may be used for recreational commercial purposes as defined in By-law Number 826.
- 2. This By-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.


