> A By-law to Amend Traffic By-law 93-93 to prohibit the parking of vehicles which project over the curb

Whereas Section 11(1) 1 of the Municipal Act, 2001 permits a local municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- Section 42 of Traffic By-law 93-93 is amended by adding the following section:
 - 42(7A) in such a manner that the vehicle is partly on a boulevard, or on public or private property,

and projects over a curb into the traveled portion of the highway;

The following is added to Traffic By-law 93-93, after Section 55: 2.

UNLICENSED VEHICLES

No person shall park an unlicensed or immobile vehicle on a highway or on municipal property.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this **6** day of January, 2006.
