# BY-LAW

Number 13-89

To amend By-law 861 (former  
Township of Chinguacousy Area  
Zoning By-law)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS  
as follows:

1. By-law 861, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by adding thereto, the following as section 16B:

"16B Restaurant Uses in Commercial Zones

Refuse storage for restaurant uses  
permitted in any commercial zone of this  
by-law shall be contained in a climate  
controlled area within a building."

(2) by adding thereto, the following as section 17(3)(4):

"17(3)(4) Refuse storage for restaurant uses  
permitted in any industrial zone of this  
by-law shall be contained in a climate  
controlled area within a building."


DECLARATION
