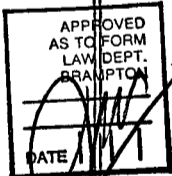
To amend By-law 151-88 (part of

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:


- (1) by changing on Schedule A, Sheet 25D thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from "INSTITUTIONAL TWO (I2)" to INSTITUTIONAL ONE (I1)", such lands being part of Lot 13, Concession 1, E.H.S., in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton.

COUNCIL, this 28th day of January 1991.



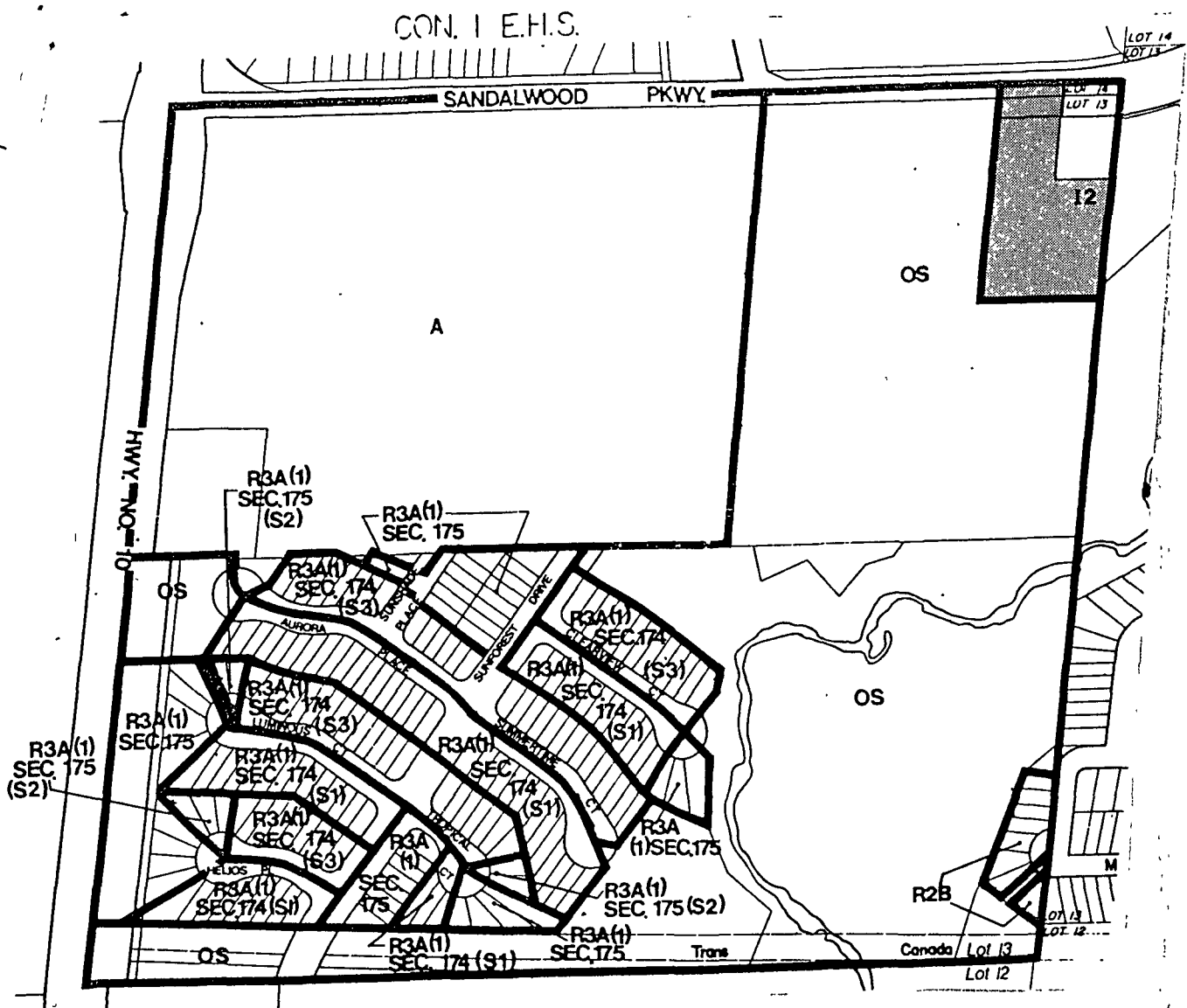


