


To assume and dedicate land

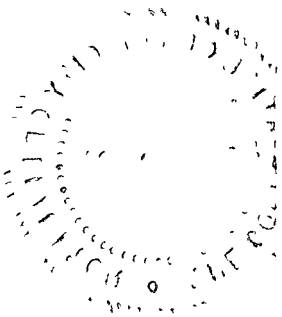
