**A by-law to amend the composition
of the Fire Grievance Committee**

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended provides that the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide for a committee of the Council to hold hearings in the place of the Council;

AND WHEREAS By-law 281-2002 established the Fire Grievance Committee, to hear grievances at Stage 4 of the grievance process, in accordance with the Collective Agreement between the Brampton Professional Firefighters Association, IAFF Local 1068 (the "Association"), and The Corporation of the City of Brampton, which provided that a meeting shall take place between the Association and the Council of the City of Brampton or an appropriate committee thereof at Stage 4 of the grievance procedure;

AND WHEREAS Council Resolution C231-2010 directed that By-law 281-2002 be amended to change the composition of the Fire Grievance Committee to be set at any five Members of Council without the need for Council appointment;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That By-law 281-2002 be amended by deleting Section 2 and substituting with the following:

"2. The Fire Grievance Committee shall be comprised of any five (5) Members of Council, without the need for Council appointment, together with such alternate Members as the Council considers necessary."
