The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


- Zoning By-Law 270-2004 is hereby further amended as follows:
 - (1). Section 20.3.3 is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "20.3.3 The lands shown outlined and identified as "Parking Exemption Area" on Schedule B to this by-law shall be exempt from the parking requirements set out in Section 20.3.2 for a commercial use only, and for a temporary period expiring on December 31, 2006."
