

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

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Number 19-79

A By-law to amend By-law 861, as amended, and particularly as amended by By-laws 87-76 and 230-78, to regulate the use of land on the northwest corner of Torbram Road and North Park Drive, Part of Lot 9, Concession 5, E.H.S., formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton.

The Council of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 87-76 is hereby amended by deleting section 3(3) and substituting the following therefor:
 - "(3) Business or professional offices, each not exceeding 92.9 square metres (1000 square feet) of gross floor area, provided that the gross floor area of all offices for the same type of business of profession shall not exceed 279.7 square metres (3000 square feet)."
- 2. By-law 87-76 is hereby further amended by deleting section 3(4) and substituting the following therefor:
 - "(4) Hardware Store"
- 3. By-law 87-76 is hereby further amended by deleting section 4(6) and substituting the following therefor:
 - "(6) The gross floor area of all areas used for any purpose or purposes permitted by each subsection of section 3, other than the purposes permitted by section 3(3), shall not exceed a gross floor area of 278.7 square metres (3000 square feet)."
- 4. This By-law shall not come into force without the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.


