(3) That Albert Solski, Treasurer be and is ~~is~~ hereby authorized for and on behalf of the corporation from time to time to receive from the said Bank a statement of the account of the corporation together with all relative vouchers and all unpaid bills lodged for collection by the corporation and all items returned unpaid and charged to the account of the corporation, and to sign and deliver to the said Bank the Bank's form of verification, settlement of balance and release.

(4) That Albert Solski, Treasurer be and is ~~is~~ hereby authorized for and on behalf of the corporation to obtain delivery from the said Bank of all or any stocks, bonds and other securities held by the said Bank in safekeeping or otherwise for the account of the corporation and to give valid and binding receipts therefor.

(5) That this resolution be communicated to the said Bank and remain in force until written notice to the contrary shall have been given to the Manager for the time being of the branch of the said Bank at which the account of the corporation is kept, and receipt of such notice duly acknowledged in writing.

THAT in respect of every cheque issued in an amount exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) up to and including One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) each officer of The Corporation of the City of Brampton who has been or who may hereafter be authorized to sign cheques on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton be and is hereby authorized to make use of a mechanical or other device for the purpose of affixing to each such cheque a facsimile of such officer's signature instead of signing such cheque manually provided that each cheque in an amount exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) up to and including One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is also countersigned manually by the Treasurer.

THAT J. Galway, Chief Administrative Officer, is hereby authorized to sign cheques in lieu of the Mayor of the Municipality.



THAT The Royal Bank of Canada be and it is



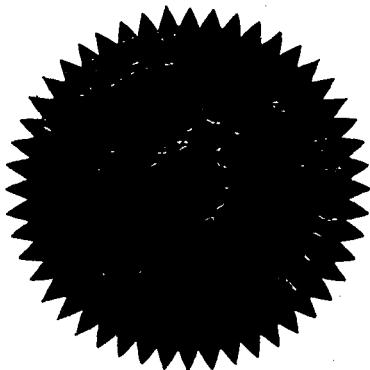

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS — BORROWING BY-LAW

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton

(herein called "the Corporation") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 50,300,000 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year;

*Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

*AND WHEREAS the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1980, is \$ 71,841,492 ;

AND WHEREAS the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in Section 332 of the Municipal Act is \$50,300,000 , of which the Corporation has already borrowed a total of \$ Nil

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time during the year in accordance with the provisions of the said Section 332 by way of promissory note from The Royal Bank of Canada (herein called "the Bank") a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate hereunder ~~Canada~~ **FIFTY MILLION, THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND** ----- Dollars (\$ 50,300,000 meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in the said Section 332, and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the corporate seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed with interest (which may be paid in advance or otherwise) at the prevailing rate from time to time of the bank.
2. All or any sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this By-law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and any previous years from the Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 332 shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole or any part or parts of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for all preceding years, as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all or any sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all or any of the moneys hereafter collected or received, either on account of or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source, which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.
4. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to furnish the Bank at the time of each borrowing with a statement showing as at that date the nature and amount of the estimated revenues for the current year where the estimated revenues have been adopted for the current year, or of the estimated revenues for the previous year where the estimated revenues have not been adopted for the current year; the nature and amount of the uncollected balance of the estimated revenues; the aggregate of borrowings made in the year under the provisions of the said Section 332; and the total of any borrowings made in the year under the said Section 332 which have not been repaid.
5. The Bank shall be entitled to rely as to the authority of any borrowing on a copy of this By-law certified by the Clerk and on the statements furnished to the Bank from time to time by the Treasurer pursuant to paragraph 4 of this By-law.
6. This By-law shall remain in full force and be binding on the Corporation as against the Bank, until a copy, certified by the Clerk under the corporate seal, of a By-law repealing or replacing this By-law, shall have been received by the Bank and duly acknowledged by it in writing.
