The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. By-law 139-84, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing on Sheet 13 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from INDUSTRIAL ONE - HOLDING - SECTION 697 (M1(H) - SECTION 697) to INDUSTRIAL ONE - SECTION 697 (M1 - SECTION 697).
 - (2) by deleting therefrom, section 697.1 and substituting therefor the following:

"697.1 The lands designated M1 - SECTION 697 on Sheet 13 of Schedule A to this by-law:"
 - (3) by deleting therefrom, section 697.1.2 (13) and (14).

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 24th day of January 1994 .




- 1. I am the Deputy Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such have knowledge of the matters herein declared.**
