# BY-LAW

Number 23-99

To change the name of  
Amphibious Avenue  
(Plans 43M-1297 and 43M-1298)

**WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of Amphibious Avenue:

**AND WHEREAS** notice of intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The name of the street shown as "Amphibious Avenue" on Registered Plans 43M-1297 and 43M-1298 which is described in Schedule A attached hereto, is changed to "Great Lakes Drive".
2. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B hereto shall form part of this by-law.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this 22nd day of February, 1999.


SCHEDULE B to By-law 23-99
