Number 33-79 being a by-law
for the Regulation of Traffic

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 33-79, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law Number 33-79 is hereby further amended by the addition to Schedule I of the following items under the appropriate columns thereof.

NO PARKING ON SPECIFIED HIGHWAYS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>COLUMN 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>COLUMN 4</u> <u>Times or days</u>
John Street.	South	Main Street and a point 45 metres easterly	Monday to Saturday inclusive
John Street	South	Chapel Street and a point 20 metres westerly	Anytime
Sandalwood Pkwy	Both	Highway No. 10 and the easterly limit of the Street	Anytime
