To amend the	Zoning By-la	w 2004 (By	-law 270-200	04) as amended

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The Zoning By-law 2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing on Sheet 38B of Schedule A thereto, the zoning reference of "A-Section 177" to "RE1-Section 177".
 - (2) by deleting "(10) The width of a driveway for a townhouse unit shall not exceed the width of the garage of the unit. (11) A balcony of porch, including eaves and cornices, may project into the minimum front yard by a maximum of 1.8 metres." from Section 3446.2 and replacing them with "(13) The width of a driveway for a townhouse unit shall not exceed the width of the garage of the unit. (14) A balcony of porch, including eaves and cornices, may project into the minimum front yard by a maximum of 1.8 metres."
 - (3) by changing all references to "1353" in Section 1353 related to R1D-Section 1353 to "479", i.e., R1D-Section 1353 in text and on Schedule A becomes R1D-Section 479, the references of 1353.1 and 1353.2 become 479.1 and 479.2 respectively.
 - (4) by changing all references to "1354" in Section 1354 related to R2A-Section 1354 to "480", i.e., R2A-Section 1354 in text and on Schedule A becomes R2A-Section 480, the references of 1354.1 and 1354.2 become 480.1 and 480.2 respectively.
