Number 30-78

To amend By-Law 13-74, to prohibit the parking or leaving of motor vehicles on Municipal or private property without authority or where signs approved by the City have been posted designating the area as a Fire Route.

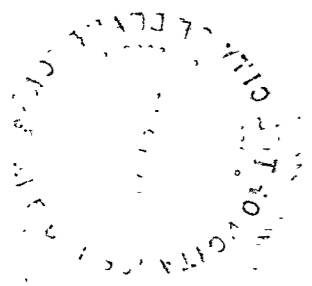
WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-Law Number 13-74; NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That Section 8 of By-Law Number 13-74 be and is hereby repealed and the following shall be substituted therefor:
 - (8) Notwithstanding all other provisions of this By-Law, any person may, upon presentation of a parking violation tag issued under this By-Law, pay out of Court within five days from the date of issue of the said tag, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, the sum of \$10.00 and upon such payment, no further proceedings shall be taken under this By-Law in respect of the said offence alleged in the parking violation tag.
2. This By-Law shall not come into force or take effect until March 20, 1978.
3. That By-Law Number 172-77 passed July 11, 1977 be and is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 6th day of February, 1978.
