AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93-13
TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE CITY
OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 28: Sandringham-Wellington to include Amendment Number 244 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.

2.0 Location

The lands subject to this amendment are situated at the north-east corner of the intersection of Bovaird Drive and Professors Lake Parkway when extended. The lands have an area of approximately 0.5 hectares (1.25 acres).

3.0 Amendment and Policies Relative Thereto:

The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:

- (1) by adding to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 28: Sandringham-Wellington, as set out in Part II: Secondary Plans, Amendment Number 244 to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.
