BY-LAW

Number 31-85
To change the name of part of Lakehurst
Street (Registered Plan M-157)

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of part of Lakehurst Street;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of the part of the street shown as "Lakehurst Street" on Registered Plan M-157, which is described in Schedule A attached hereto, is changed to "Lord Simcoe Drive".
