



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 32-97

To further amend By-law 4-83,
as amended, respecting the
City of Brampton Safety Council

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 4-83, which established, created terms of reference and determined the composition of the City of Brampton Safety Council.

On February 10, 1997, City Council adopted recommendation AF017-97 which recommended flexibility in the citizen membership on the Safety Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Bylaw 4-83, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) by deleting section 1a) and substituting therefor the following:

"a) No fewer than five and no more than eight persons, as City Council determines by resolution, who are not members of City Council or Regional Council or a local board as defined in section 1 of the Municipal Affairs Act (R.S.O. 1990, c.M.46), all of whom shall be appointed by resolution of City Council for a term of office to run concurrently with the term of office for City Council."

(2) by deleting section 2 and substituting therefor the following:

2. "a) Each member of the Safety Council, excluding those members described in section 1a), shall hold office during the calendar year in which he or she is appointed and until his or her successor is appointed.


b) If a member of the Safety Council described in section 1a) is absent for three (3) consecutive meetings for reasons other than health or extraordinary circumstances as defined

by City Council, that member shall be disqualified from serving on the Safety Council for the balance of the term. City Council shall not be required to select a replacement for any disqualified member until the number of members described in section 1a) serving on the Safety Council is less than five."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of February, 1997.
