# BY-LAW

**Number** 32-99

To provide for the levy and collection of interim taxes for residential, farmland, and managed forest properties for the year 1999.

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WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the levy and collection of interim taxes for the year 1999 by instalments and to impose penalties on all current levies and interest on all arrears of taxes pursuant to sections 370, 392, 399, and 419 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, C.M.45, as amended;


AND WHEREAS section 370 of the *Municipal Act* provides for an interim levy, on the assessment for real property according to the most recently revised assessment roll, of a sum not exceeding fifty per cent (50%) of the total amount raised for all purposes in the previous year by the levying of tax rates on all the properties that, in the current year, are in the property class.

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. 1.1 That for the year 1999 there shall be levied and collected a sum calculated using tax rates set out in Schedule "A" attached to this by-law against current value assessment for those properties in the residential, farmland, and managed forest property classes;
- 1.2 That there may be added to the Collector's Roll all or any arrears of charges, fees, costs, or other expenses as may be permitted by Provincial legislation and such arrears of charges, fees, costs, or other expenses shall be deemed to be taxes, collected as taxes, or collected in the same manner as municipal taxes, or dealt with in such fashion as may be specifically authorized by the applicable statute; and
- 1.3 That such levies made under subsection 1.1 shall be due and payable in three instalments as follows:
  - March 10, 1999
  - April 12, 1999
  - May 12, 1999.
2. 2.1 That the Treasurer shall add a percentage charge as a penalty for default of payment of the instalments in accordance with By-law No. 262-94.
- 2.2 That the Treasurer shall also add a percentage charge as interest in accordance with By-law No. 262-94.

3. That the Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept part-payment from time to time on account of any taxes due and to give a receipt for such a part-payment, provided that acceptance of any such part-payment does not affect the collection of any percentage charge imposed and collectable under the provision of By-law No. 262-94 in respect of non-payment of any taxes or any class of taxes or of any instalment thereof.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME and passed in Open Council this **22<sup>nd</sup> day of February, 1999.**


