Number 35-2004

To authorize surplus lands and
release of a transfer of an easement

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City release a transfer of easement over Part of Lot 6, Concession 10 (N.D.) designated as Part 5 on Plan 43R-27716 and over Part of Lots 1 and 2, 43M-1582 designated as Part 7 on 43R-27716 (the "Lands");

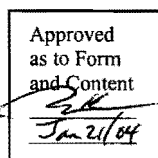
AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The release of the transfer of easement over the Lands for nominal consideration is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of the said lands.
