



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 36-92

To amend By-law 193-83 (the regulation of traffic) for the placement of an ALL WAY STOP on Countryside Drive and Torbram Road and a STOP SIGN at Deeside Crescent and Drake Boulevard

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following item:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1
HIGHWAY

COLUMN 2
BETWEEN

Torbram Road

The south limit of Mayfield Road and the north limit of Steeles Avenue East

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following item:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1
HIGHWAY

COLUMN 2
BETWEEN

Torbram Road

The south limit of Countryside Drive and the north limit of Steeles Avenue East

(3) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule X thereto the following item:

YIELD SIGNS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>FACING TRAFFIC</u>
Deeside Crescent and Drake Boulevard (easterly intersection)	Eastbound on Drake Boulevard


(4) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule IX thereto the following items:

Countryside Drive and Torbram Road	Westbound on Countryside Drive

Countryside Drive and Torbram Road	Southbound on Torbram Road
Deeside Crescent and Drake Boulevard (easterly intersection)	Eastbound on Drake Boulevard



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
