A by-law to amend Woodlot Conservation By-law 402-2005

WHEREAS By-law 402-2005 was passed pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, s. 391(1) to prohibit or regulate the destruction or injuring of trees in woodlots designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Committee of Council Recommendation CW048-2006 approved by City Council on February 13, 2006, fees related to permits under the Woodlot Conservation By-law are to be a part of the User Fee By-law, rather than incorporated within the Woodlot Conservation By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That By-law 402-2005 is hereby amended by deleting in subsection 6.2 (a) and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(a) be accompanied by the applicable fee as prescribed in User Fee Bylaw 380-2003, as amended";
- 2. That By-law 402-2005 is hereby further amended to delete Schedule "A".
