WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that Bovaird Drive be realigned;

AND WHEREAS to effect this realignment it is necessary that certain parts of Bovaird Drive be stopped up and closed and sold to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in The Daily Times and The Guardian, both of which newspapers are published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 51 of The
Regional Municipality of Peel Act, 1973, and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That parts of Bovaird Drive more particularly described in Schedule A attached to this by-law be and the same are hereby stopped up and closed.
- The conveyance of that part of the lands stopped up and closed by this by-law as more particularly described in Schedule B attached hereto, in exchange for a conveyance of the lands more particularly described in Schedule C attached hereto is hereby authorized.
- The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the lands stopped up and closed by this by-law and to acquire the lands necessary for the realignment of Bovaird Drive.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of February, 1980.
