



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 38-2007

To amend By-law 270-91, as amended, being a by-law to establish the size of the Brampton Public Library Board

WHEREAS By-law 270-91 provides for the size and composition of the Brampton Library Board;

WHEREAS, by resolution passed by City Council on January 29, 2007, it is deemed appropriate to further amend By-law 270-91, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby deleted and the following substituted:

"WHEREAS subsection 9 (1) of the *Public Libraries Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, as amended, provides that a public library shall be composed of at least five (5) members, appointed by the municipal council; and

WHEREAS subsection 10 (2) of the *Public Libraries Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, as amended, provides that the appointing council shall not appoint more of its own members to a board than a number that is one less than a majority of the board:"

2. That paragraph 1 of By-law 270-91 is hereby deleted and the following substituted:

"The Brampton Public Library Board shall be composed of the following who shall be appointed by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton

- a minimum of two (2) Members of Council
- two (2) citizens who shall be nominated by the Peel District School Board
- two (2) citizens who shall be nominated by the Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board
- three (3) citizens who shall be appointed by Council."

Read a first, second and third time and passed this 29th day of January, 2007.
