A by-law to prohibit motor vehicles being allowed to stand unattended unless locked

WHEREAS under paragraph 133 of section 210 of the Municipal Act, Council may pass by-laws for prohibiting certain persons from allowing a motor vehicle other than a commercial vehicle to stand unattended unless it is locked;

THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

- 1. No person driving or in charge of a motor vehicle, other than a commercial motor vehicle, shall allow the motor vehicle to stand unattended unless it is locked in such a manner as to prevent its operation by any person not authorized by the owner, driver or person in charge.
- 2. In this by-law, the terms "motor vehicle" and "commercial motor vehicle" shall mean "motor vehicle" and "commercial motor vehicle" as defined in the Highway Traffic Act.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the <u>Provincial Offences Act</u>.
