BY-LAW

Number 41 - 2001

To accept and assume works in
Registered Plan M-216; and to repeal
By-law No. 225-96

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has, by resolution, decided that all works constructed and installed in accordance with the subdivision agreement for Registered Plan M-216 be accepted and assumed;

AND WHEREAS Council has authorized the City Treasurer to release all securities;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume the streets (and street widenings, when applicable) on Registered Plan M-216 as part of the public highway system.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby **ENACTS** as follows:

1. All of the works constructed and installed in accordance with the subdivision agreement for Registered Plan M-216 are hereby accepted and assumed.
2. The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.
3. By-law No. 225-96 is hereby repealed
