## **BY-LAW**

Number 41-2004

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1373

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of block 176 on Registered Plan 43M-1373.

We do not need to repeal the by-law now because the owner and his agent are working a new plan with advice from the Planning Department. The new plan will propose wider lots than the one deposited with the initial lifting of the part lot control by-law, but it will require a number of variances both for the lots and the townhouses to be built. The variance application is submitted and will be dealt with soon. Following the appeal deadline of the variances, the applicant can then deposit the new plan. As a part of the "new" part lot control process, the part lot control bylaw should then be put back in place.
